

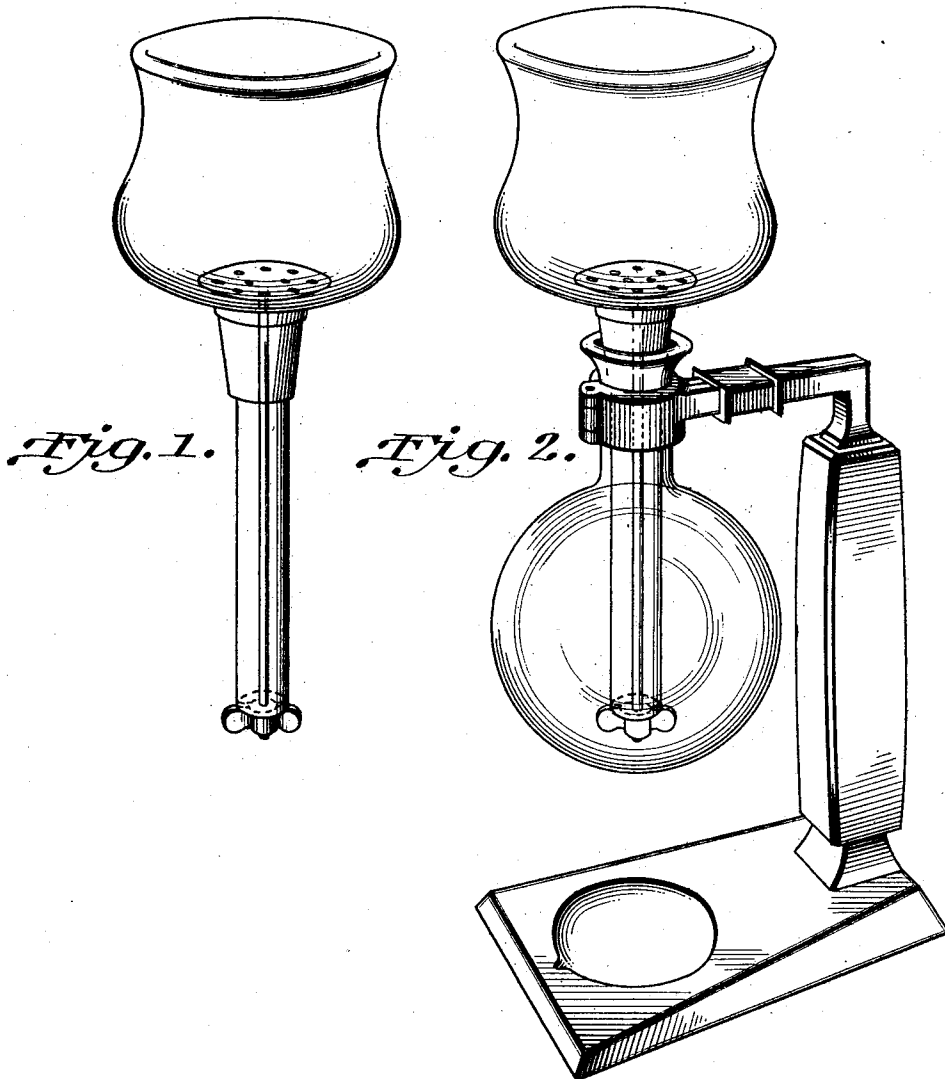

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, GERHARD BEHREND, a subject of the Emperor of Germany, and a resident of the county of Kings, city and State of New York, one of the United States of America, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Coffee-Percolators, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 2 is a perspective view of a coffee percolator with all the parts assembled, and

Fig. 1 is a view of the upper receptacle thereof separate, showing my new design.
